2. Compliance Overview for Consumers

COVID-19 compliance is mandatory per DPH, WHO, Osha and MassHealth to ensure the safety of members and staff.

Requirement:

- 1. Masks must always be worn and must cover mouth and nose. Please complete training on proper use of mask.
 - a. When anyone needs to sneeze, please do not remove your mask
 - b. If you need to blow you nose, please use the bathroom
- **3.** Everyone must sanitize their hands before entering the building
- **4.** We must ALWAYS maintain 6 feet for Social distance. Please demonstrate what 6 feet of social distance is and outline what all the dots and blue marks mean.
- 5. Van protocols
 - a. Social distancing in vehicles
 - b. No one can ride in the front except the driver
 - c. Everyone must sanitize before entering the van
 - d. Temperatures will be taken before entering the vehicles
 - e. Everyone always needs to keep their mask on while on the van

- f. Vans will be sanitized after every run
- g. Drivers will inform the "GERMBUSTER" upon their arrival at the program to ensure sanitation is completed immediately
- h. Clear plastic barriers are always in each van to ensure driver and passenger safety

6. Pool

- i. Equipment is to be sanitized after every use
- j. Masks must always be worn
- k. Participants will sanitize hands after each game
- I. Social distance marks are located at each table, only one person can be at the pool table at a time
- m. When waiting for your shot you must sit or stand on the 6 foot markers on the floor
- 7. Dominos
 - n. Only two players at a time
 - o. Once the dominos are divided each player must sanitize their hands
 - p. Masks must always be worn
 - q. All players must maintain 6 feet of social distance
- 8. Karaoke/BAND
 - r. Masks must always be worn
 - s. Microphone covers must be used
 - t. Must maintain 6 feet of social distance
- 9. Dancing
 - u. Masks must always be worn
 - v. Must maintain 6 feet of social distance
- **10.** Exercise/Exercise Equipment

- w. Masks must always be worn
- x. Must maintain 6 feet of social distance
- y. All equipment must be sanitized after each use
- **11.** Arts/Crafts
 - z. Masks must always be worn
 - aa. Must maintain 6 feet of social distance
 - ab. All markers, paint brushes and crayons will be sanitized after each use, these can not be shared until they have been sanitized
- **12.** Food (Breakfast, Lunch and Snack)
 - ac. Masks must always be worn until seated at table and appropriately distanced from others
 - ad. Must maintain 6 feet of social distance
 - ae. Meals will be delivered with minimal contact.
 - af. All drinks including water and coffee will be served by employees
 - ag. Meals will be delivered one at a time on a tray
 - ah. Staff will clear all tables

Staff Requirements

Mandated: Masks are MANDATORY; they need to cover both your nose and mouth. Face Shields are required

- 1. Breakfast is to be consumed before starting your shift at your home
- 2. Lunch can not be provided by the program and needs to be brought in from home.
- **3.** No congregating in groups; must always maintain 6 feet of distance with other team members.
- 4. No sharing drinks or food
- **5.** Each employee must eat in designated areas alone or in setting with 6 feet of social distance
- **6.** Staff will assist in the cleaning and sanitation of the program daily
- 7. The "Germ-Buster" will be:
 - a. Sanitizing all bathrooms and high tough areas hourly
 - b. Sanitizing the vans after every trip
 - c. Sanitizing the entire building at the close of each day
 - c.i. Including all interior and exterior door handles
 - c.ii. Outside gate
 - c.iii. Outdoor tables and chairs
 - c.iv. The legs of the pop-up tents
 - c.v. All chairs/tables

COVID 19 Quarantine Room

This will be the shower stall bathroom near the nursing office

- ✓ Masks must always be worn
- ✓ Must maintain 6 feet of social distance

- ✓ Proper monitoring is mandatory
- ✓ Transportation home from family or caregiver when applicable; in-house transport and or EMS transport
